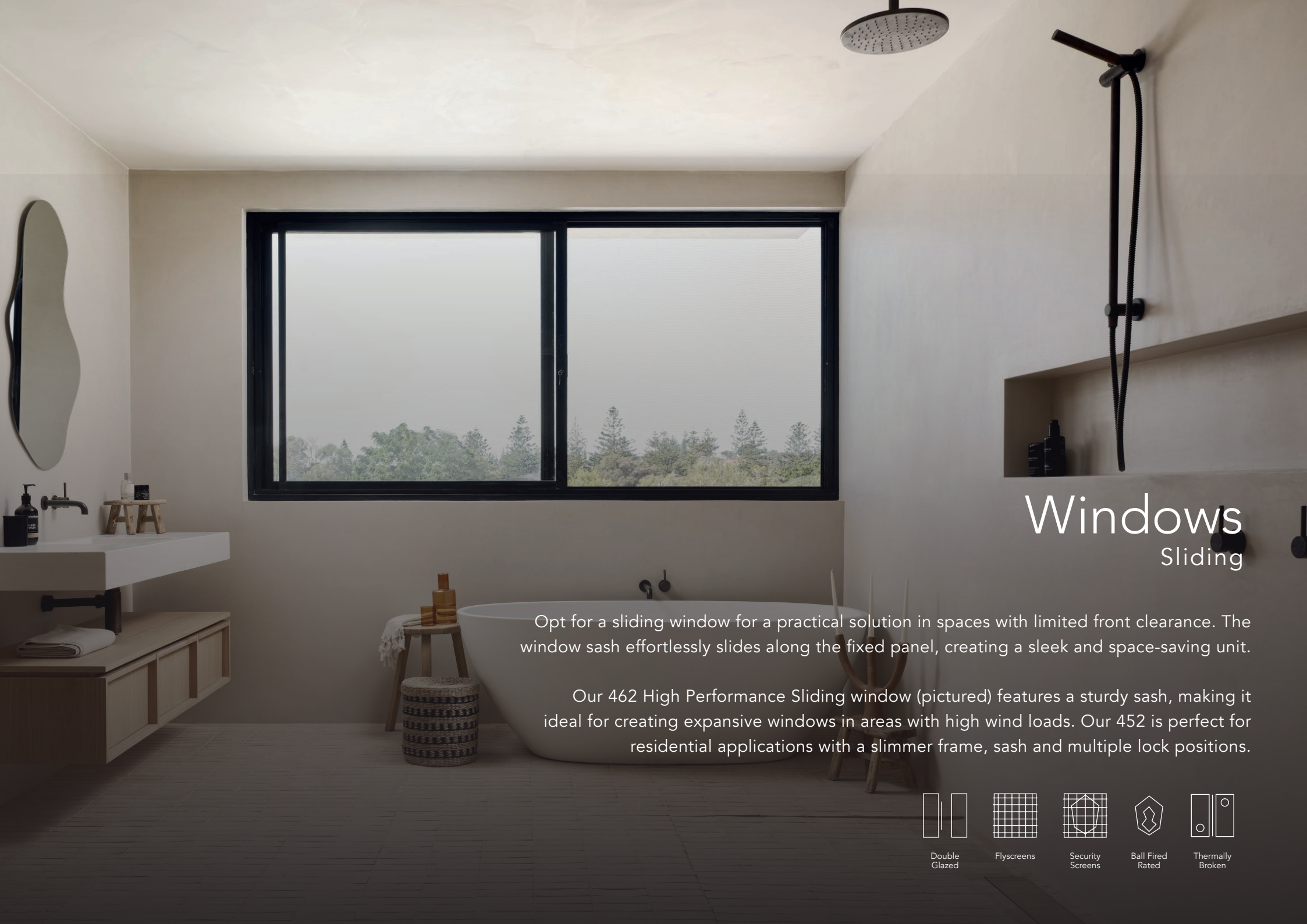

Sliding Doors

AWS 704/704FBR

The AWS 704/704FBR series commercial sliding and stacker doors are designed for applications where the sill needs to be recessed.

By recessing the sill, the internal and external floor levels align, eliminating the need to step over the sill when passing through. This feature is beneficial for wheelchair access and the elderly.

The AWS 704 series is available in heights up to 3 metres and panel widths up to 2 metres.

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Pivot Doors

Framed

A pivot door is a great option for an entry door to your home or office.

A pivot door rotates on two metal pivots at the top and bottom of the door. This allows the door to be open out and in. The door is usually fitted with an concealed overhead closer which allows the door to be set open at different positions.

Pivot Doors

Frameless

The clean unobstructed lines of a frameless pivot door make it a popular entry door for a restaurant, shop or office. The Frameless door comes with stainless steel patch fittings and handles to add a modern touch.

The door is usually fitted with a concealed overhead closer which allows the door to be set open at different positions.
